Andreas Fischlin, 1949, studied Biology and Systems Theory. He researched in Canada and Switzerland population dynamics and the impacts of climate change on ecosystems. He taught at University and ETH Zurich computer science and systems ecology. He played a leading role in the formation of the curriculum and department of Environmental Systems Science at ETH Zurich. He was presented the Nobel Peace Prize 2007 as awarded to IPCC for his work as coordinating lead author in the Fourth Assessment Report. For 17 years he represented Swiss scientists in the UNFCCC Swiss delegation. Until recently he was IPCC Vice-Chair WGII.
